



US Domestic Content & Traceability Requirement (IRA Compliance)

- All materials supplied under this Purchase Order shall comply with the requirements of the Inflation Reduction Act, including applicable U.S. domestic content provisions.
- All steel products must be manufactured in the United States in accordance with “melt and pour” requirements, meaning that all melting, refining, and initial shaping processes occur within the United States.
- The Supplier shall provide full traceability documentation for all steel materials, including but not limited to:
 - Mill Test Certificates (MTCs)
 - Heat numbers and production records
 - Country of origin certifications
 - Documentation confirming U.S. melt and pour compliance
- Such documentation must be submitted prior to shipment or upon request and shall be sufficient to verify compliance with all applicable domestic content requirements.
- Failure to meet these requirements may result in rejection of materials, withholding of payment, or other remedies as permitted under this Purchase Order.
- Supplier, by accepting this Purchase Order, represents and warrants full compliance with all applicable Foreign Entity of Concern (FEOC) requirements. Any breach of this representation shall render the Supplier fully liable for all resulting losses, damages, and costs incurred by Buyer, including without limitation any loss of tax credits or regulatory penalties, which shall be recoverable on a full indemnity basis.
